

Bicycle Museum Ride

August 7 - 10, 2018

Start in Vermilion, end at New Bremen, approximately 162 miles.
Ride Leader Ed Stewart; anticipated pace about 13 mph.
Anticipate 8 riders, using one or two car vans and one U-Haul truck
Travel expenses and driving to be shared.
Complete map sets and details available for each rider.

Day 1: Vermilion to Tiffin, about 55 miles

Tuesday, August 7

Leave from **Bud Ennis's** home in Vermilion in morning.
Lunch stop in **Bellevue** (about 34 miles)
Afternoon break in **Green Springs** (mile 46)
After lunch ride to **Tiffin**. (mile 55)
Stay overnite at **Hampton Inn. 2492 South State Rt. 231**

Day 2: Tiffin to Upper Sandusky, about 25 miles

Wednesday, August 8

Leave **Tiffin**, enjoy a casual ride to the next stop.
Maybe stop for a picnic for lunch.

Day 3: Upper Sandusky to Wapokoneta, about 65 miles

Thursday, August 9

Leave Upper Sandusky early
Early Lunch in Kenton (about 25 miles)
Stay in Wapokoneta at **Holiday Inn Express, 1510 Saturn Dr.**

Day 4: Wapokoneta to New Bremen, about 17 miles

Friday, August 10

Leave Wapok, ride to New Bremen
Bicycle Museum is near downtown area; open 9-5 Mon-Fri only.
After spending time in museum and lunch, we will drive back to Wapokaneta
to visit the **Temple of Tolerance**, a unique garden of rocks from all over the world.
